Dear Saint-in-the-Making,
Practice spreading the Gospel with a
friend, grandchild, etc. using these words:
CREATED: Why is there something rather
than nothing? Because there's a Creator,
who created us out of love and for love...
CAPTURED: Why is everything so messed
up? (What the "hell" happened?) Because of
the envy of the devil, sin and death entered
the world; we are born captured by sin,
death, and the devil, and we cannot save
ourselves. We are in "enemy occupied
territory"...

RESCUED: What has God done about it? He invaded this "enemy occupied territory" by sending a Rescuer, His Only Son, who became an "ambush predator" on the cross, tricking the devil, and defeating sin, death and the devil by dying and opening the gates of heaven, and...
