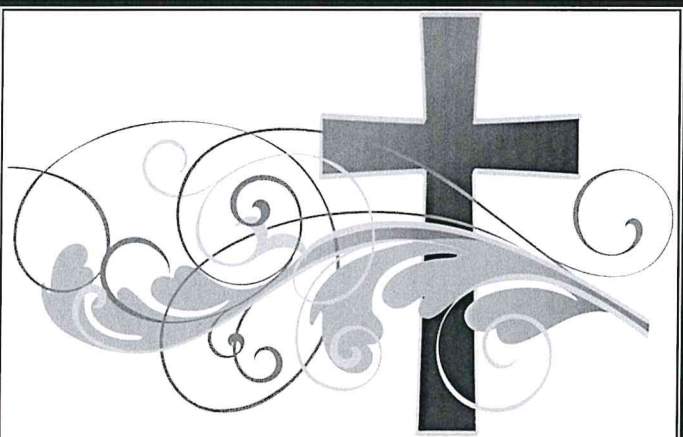

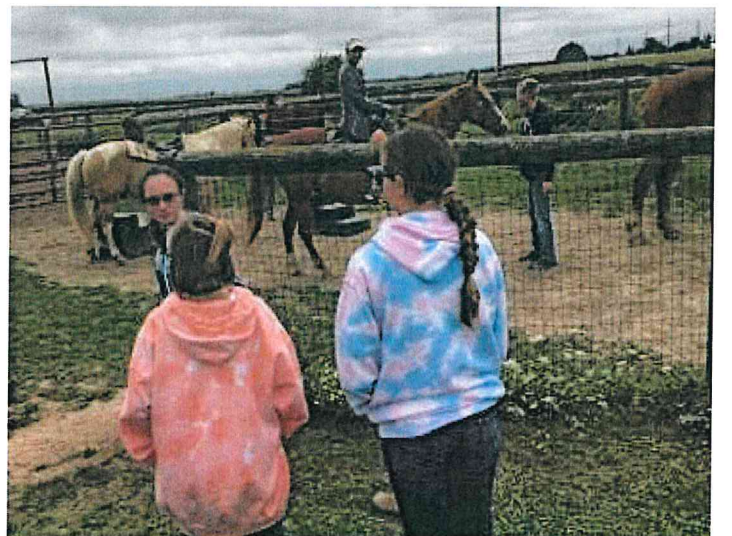

World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly

This day is celebrated throughout the Church in the United States on September 10, 2023. The theme chosen by the Holy Father is "His mercy is from age to age" (Luke 1:50). He wants to remind us how "God's mercy is manifested in history through those who have experienced it and passed it on to their children and grandchildren" (Pope Francis' message for World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly 2023).

Prayer of Grandparents for their Grandchildren

Heavenly Father, Thank you for the gift of our grandchildren.

Help us to lead them to grow in happiness and holiness

and to become the saints you want them to become.

Help us to model for our grandchildren what it is to be a true man or woman of God, and what it is to be an intentional disciple of Christ.

Guide us in teaching our grandchildren to know, love, and follow Christ, and to be guided by His Church, through our example, and if possible and prudent, through our words.

Help us to show them through our example of how to encounter Christ in silence and scripture,

and in the sacraments of Eucharist and Reconciliation.

Make us "witnesses of the Lord's mercy" that extends from "age to age."

We ask You for:

The wisdom to counsel them;

The patience to teach them;

The humility to entrust them to your care.

Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, watch over our entire family, and keep us all on the path to our true home.

Visiting the elderly who are alone (USCCB.org)

- In order for the message of closeness and consolation that the Day seeks to express to reach everyone - even those who are most isolated - we suggest making visits to the lonely elderly in your community and deliver the Holy Father's message to them
- The visit, a tangible sign of the Church that goes forth, is a way to reaffirm that the elderly, even the loneliest, are at the center of our communities.
- Visits express the personal choice to get up and go quickly towards others (cf. Lk 1:39), just as Mary did to visit the elderly Elizabeth.
- The visit may be an opportunity to bring a gift, such as a flower, and to read the Day's message and prayer together.
- Visiting an elderly person is one of the possibilities for obtaining the Plenary Indulgence granted on the occasion of the Day.
