
Dear Saint-in-the-Making,

New Divine Mercy Image on Rectory Wall

Pope St. John Paul II said that the Divine Mercy image portrays the Risen Jesus Christ bringing Mercy to the whole world. This outdoor banner was paid for by donations from a parishioner. The idea of putting it there was my own. I'm praying the image will help folks driving out of the parking lot (including myself) to encounter Jesus and lead them to pray, "Jesus I trust in You".

Jesus gives grace to all who see any version of the divine mercy image. He said to St. Faustina: "By means of this image I shall be granting many graces to souls; so let every soul have access to it" (Diary, 570).

"I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I also promise victory over [its] enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death..." (Diary, 48).

"I am offering people a vessel with which they are to keep coming for graces to the fountain of mercy. That vessel is this image with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You". (Diary 327)

"...I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it." (Diary 341)

"The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous [baptism]. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls [Eucharist]. These two rays issued forth from the very depths of My tender mercy when My agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the cross. ...Happy is the one who will dwell in their shelter, for the just hand of God shall not lay hold of him." (Diary 299)




