I went to Main Street Mercantile in Bad Axe
(989) 269-5070), paid the setup fee, and they

station attendant who saw the logo, etc.

<u>Dear Saint-in-the-Making,</u> <u>The Lord loves to hear from His children.</u>

That's why He taught us this prayer, "Speak, Lord, your servant is listening." Have you heard the Lord speak to you lately? To hear God, we must make time every day for silence and scripture.

When I was discerning whether Jesus was calling me to the priesthood, I spent extra time in silence and scripture in the adoration chapel. Jesus spoke to me especially through Luke 18.

When we make time for silence and scripture, we shouldn't spend the whole time reading. When something pops out at us, we should stop and spend time with it; chew on it. We might spend our entire prayer time meditating on one phrase!

I found my mom's prayer journal she used before she died. On many pages, she has the letters ACTS + L written on the left side. A for Adoration: She wrote words of adoration. C for Contrition: wrote sin(s) and asked forgiveness. T for Thanksgiving; S for Supplication. AND she wrote L for Listening; she spent time waiting on the Lord in silence. She wrote down at least one thing she believed our Lord was saying to her. It may help you to try this!

Whenever we have <u>Adoration with</u> <u>our Faith Formation children</u>, and any parents or parishioners who attend, I invite them to listen to God in silence, to listen, like Samuel, etc., and Jesus Himself.

God loves to hear from His children! Whenever I visit nieces and nephews, they ask me questions. I love to speak to them, and share what I've learned. Our Loving God never ever gets tired of speaking to us when we make time for silence and scripture.

Whenever we do, it consoles the Heart of Jesus. His divine and human heart hurts for all the people who never even try to listen, who never make time to listen. Listening to God consoles Him and quenches His burning thirst for love.

Because I love you, I strongly urge you to make time for silence and scripture every day. Begin by praying, "Speak, Lord, your servant is listening."

Please pray for all who saw the many people who attended the March for Life in DC, especially those who need conversion of heart.


