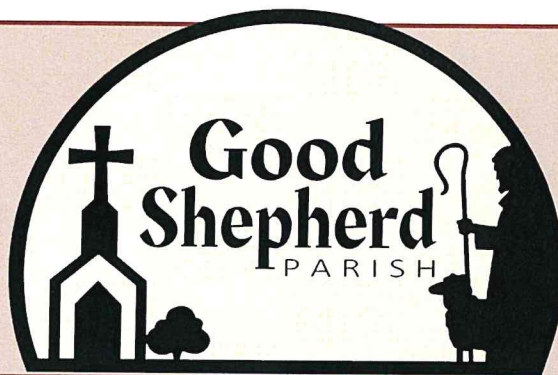

Right to Life Dinner

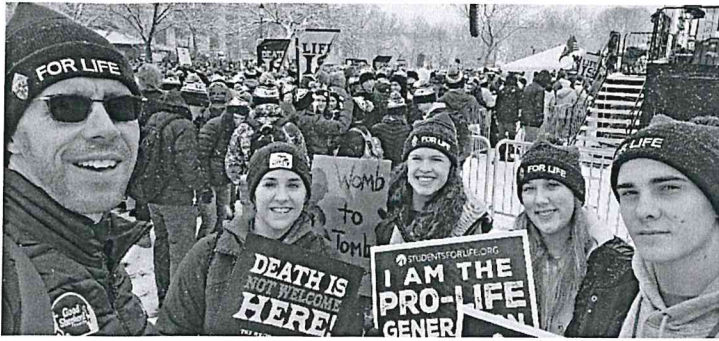

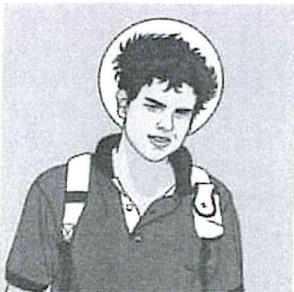

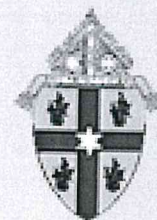
