




*Dear Saint-in-the-Making,  
Happy Lord's Day!*

It was such a gift from our Lord to participate in the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage in Indiana this past Monday. I was one of about 75 pilgrims who processed with Jesus in the Eucharist 10 miles from Waterloo to Auburn. About six priests took turns carrying Jesus in the monstrance. We had a police escort for safety. This pilgrimage, which includes four simultaneous processions along four routes, will end up in Indianapolis next week at the Eucharistic Congress. My dad and I will be attending two out of the five days of the congress.

As I processed with Jesus a few inches from my face, I was deeply moved, almost to the point of tears. Jesus, my Beloved, my Lord, my Savior, the Bridegroom of my soul, allowing me to carry Him as a parent carries a child, allowing Him to radiate His love and grace to everyone in the area.

One child saw us from his second floor window and yelled greetings to us. Did He know Jesus was passing by? Many cars and bikers past by and looked. Did they know Jesus was passing by? When we walked past a gas station, some people knelt on the hard, hot concrete in love and adoration. They knew Jesus was passing by. We passed some elderly people who bowed towards the Eucharist, unable to kneel. They knew. By our reverence, we satisfy His thirst for love and faith. What this crying, broken needs more than anything else is Jesus. "The greatest love story of all time is contained in a tiny white host", said Venerable Bishop Fulton Sheen. -Love, Fr. Nate
