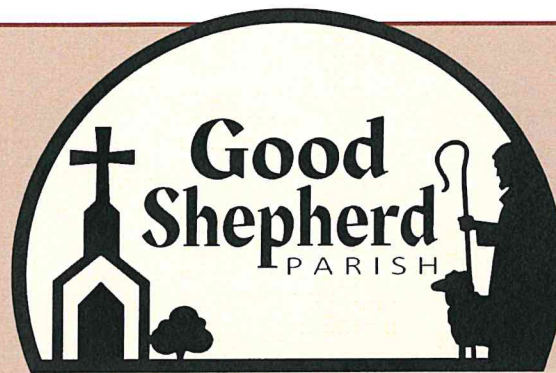

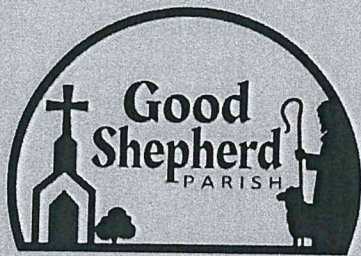

Testimony of our Perfect Mother *by Catherine Brinkman*

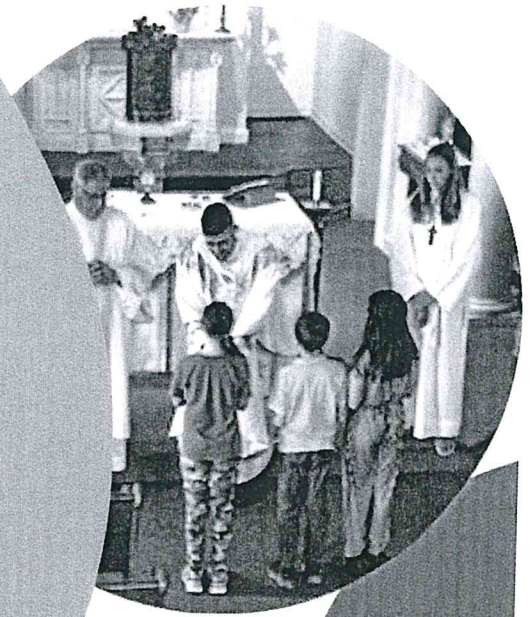
"When I moved to the thumb area in 2015 I was in the middle of a scary and quite

tragic time in my life. My mom had given me a book "33 Days to Morning Glory" several years prior to that and I had never read it or given it much attention. I remember waking up one morning, shortly after moving here, to find this book laying on the floor of my living room. I still had several boxes that I had not unpacked at this point and I hadn't unpacked my boxes of books at this point either. I didn't think much of it and decided to unpack all of my books into my office area and I put this particular book on the top shelf. The next morning, this same book was laying on the floor just outside of my bedroom. That got my attention a little. I questioned [my daughter] Wynter about this but we both had no idea how the book came to be on the floor. I was frustrated that I couldn't figure out how this book kept getting on the floor and yet again, put the book on the top shelf of my office (clearly out of reach of young children) and not in the path of my bedroom. Anyway, the very next morning this book was on the floor of my bedroom and I finally picked it up and began reading it. I don't deserve the love and attention that the Blessed Mother has shown me but I truly believe it was her, through our Lord, that placed this book in my path so that she could hold my hand and protect Wynter and I. Thus began my journey towards our Lord who I had abandoned several years before... She really took my hand and led me through some very difficult times but always on the path towards our Lord....I am so grateful for the wonderful gift God has given us in making the perfect Mother."
