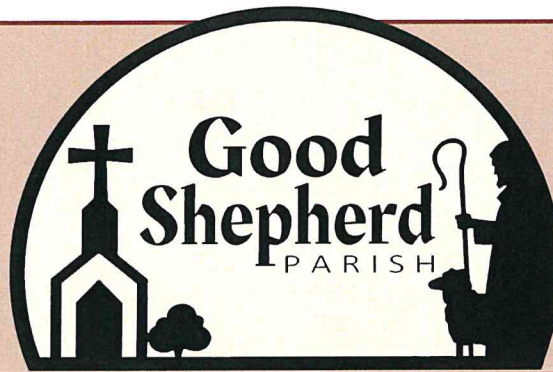

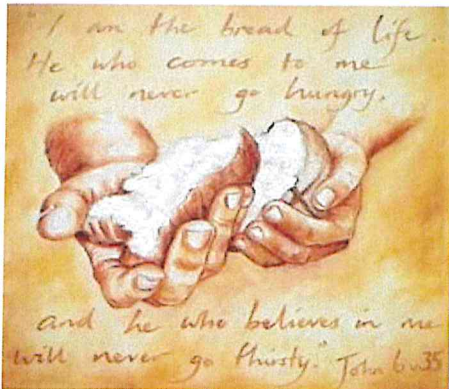

The Memorare ("Remember" in Latin) prayer was popularized in the 17th century by Fr. Claude Bernard (d. 1641), who said that he learned it from his father. It's originally from a longer prayer of the 15th century. The Catholic Church provides for the gaining of a partial indulgence by devoutly reciting the Memorare under the normal conditions.

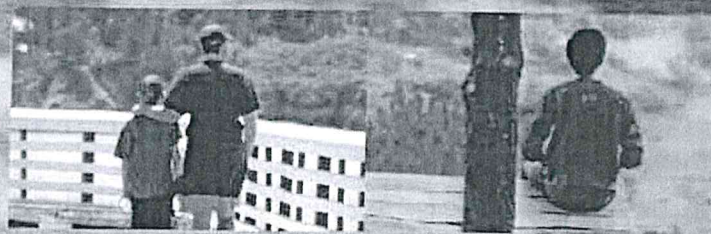
