

## Dear Missionary Disciple, Happy Lord's Day!



The blessing of Jesus through His priest makes a difference in the spiritual atmosphere; Christ drives out enemy spirits such as discouragement, unforgiveness, anxiety, etc. Marriage and family are under attack by our culture which is under the influence of our enemy. Sr. Lucia, one of the visionaries of Our Lady of Fatima, wrote, "The final battle between the Lord and the reign of Satan will be about marriage and the family." "To Jesus through Mary",
