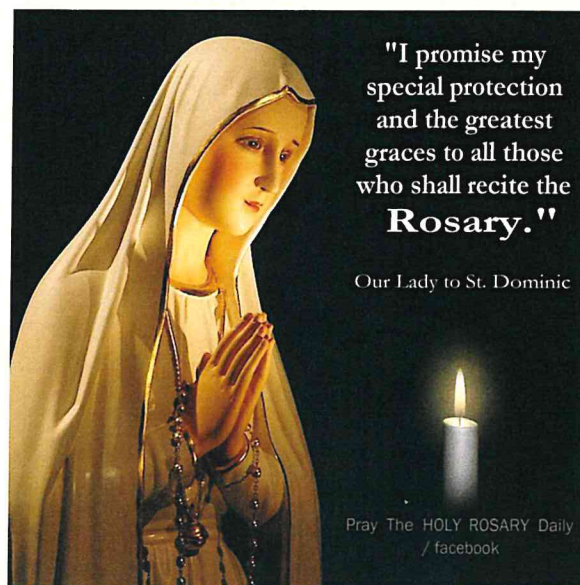

Dear Disciple on Mission,

I write to you from the hotel lobby computer in Madrid, Spain, waiting until our Camino pilgrimage begins! I will be walking in honor my mother Barb, with whom I walked the Camino for five days in 2019. I'll offer up any discomforts for her in case she needs any more purgatory, and also for you and for every parishioner. I have a list of prayer requests I'll be lifting up to our Lord and Lady every day of this pilgrimage at the holy sites. I offered up the plane ride from Charlotte to Madrid. Let's just say it was more like purgatory than heaven. When the pilot said, "I hope you enjoyed your flight!" when we landed, I laughed out loud! Why? Because many times throughout the entire overnight flight two adorable children were laughing and screaming and playing. Jesus reminded me of his words, "Unless you convert and become like children you will not enter the Kingdom of Heaven." I know he was delighting in the children's playfulness and innocence, while at the same time, inspiring me to pray for the parents and to offer up my own... shall we say, non-delight at the challenge of sleeping!



When parishioners or guests "let the little children" come to Jesus by bringing them to Mass, and don't take them out when they're a little noisy, they might be hoping to train them to "get used to Mass", and not respond to minor misbehavior by taking them out. If they take them out every time, the children might associate misbehavior with the "reward" of leaving the Mass. I encourage you to intentionally introduce yourself to parents who bring children, and say an encouraging word to them. Ask the Holy Spirit what to say. Perhaps something like, "I'm glad you brought your kid to Mass today! I'm praying for you!" ---TO JESUS THROUGH MARY, LOVE, FR. NATE


