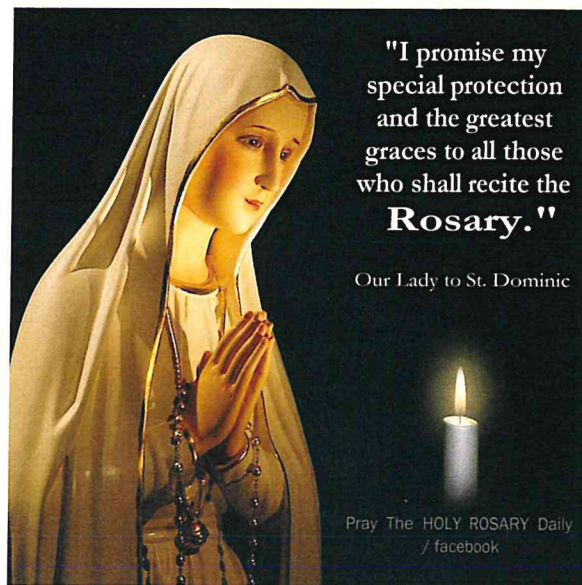

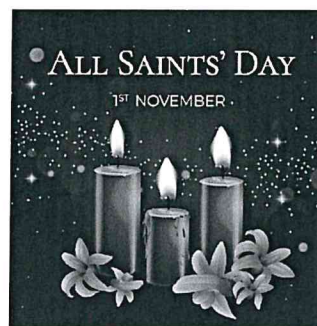

Dear “Disciple on Mission”,
I prayed for all parishioners daily on the Camino Pilgrimage from Madrid to Santiago, walking 10-18 miles per day with about 15 pilgrims in our group from all over the USA and the Philippines. Our tour guide, Jorge,

was full of love for Jesus and His Church, and taught us a lot of beautiful theology besides explaining the sights and foods and churches we saw throughout the journey.

Everyone has a reason they walk this difficult, exhausting, and sometimes blister-footed journey. I walked the Camino in thanksgiving for the gift of my Mother- in her memory- and for the intentions and salvation of you, my parish family.

The highlights included getting to know the 15 members of our group and hearing how the Lord has worked and is working in their lives. The joy of Christ shone out of each of them in different ways!

Another highlight was going to Adoration at Santiago Church. Spending quiet time with Jesus in the Eucharist refreshed and nourished my soul with His love and Presence. Have you been to Adoration at our parish? There are multiple opportunities this week: Wed. 4:30-5pm at St. John, Wed. 7-7:30pm at St. Columbkille, and Fri. 9:30am-4pm at St. John. Stop in for 5 minutes and let Jesus wash your feet!

I voted absentee yesterday. Before I voted, I learned about the candidates, did research, considered Catholic teachings and the seriousness of the issues (especially the most important issue, the legalized murder of our innocent brothers and sisters) and asked the Holy Spirit to guide me. We are not called to be one-issue voters, but the abortion issue is the most important issue.

Today, preach the truth to yourself: “I am a beloved daughter/son of our Heavenly Father, and for that LOVE and that TRUTH, I give Him thanks.”

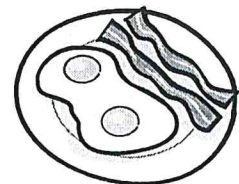
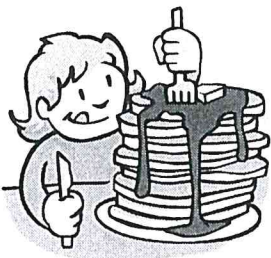
