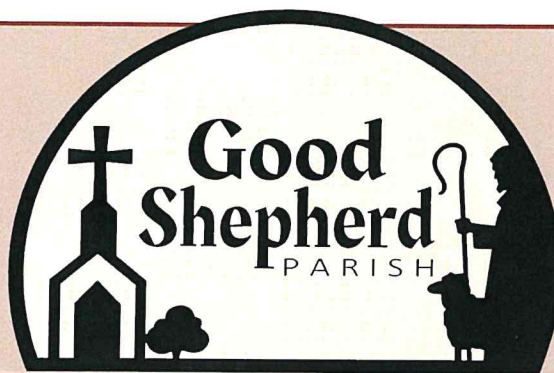

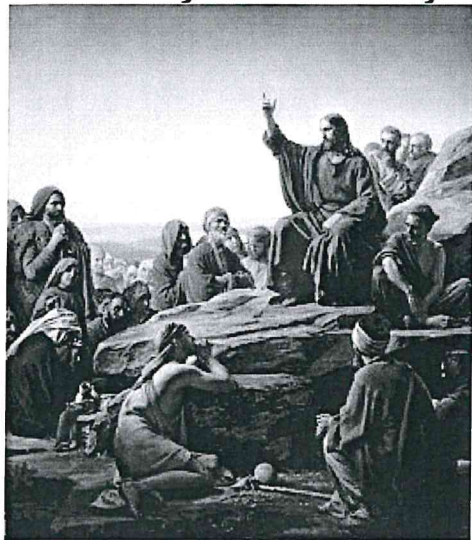

## **Faith Formation Priority:**

Definition/Rationale Statement: Lifelong faith formation is for all ages and deepens the initial conversion to faith. As part of the mission of God’s Church, it equips disciples of Christ to share and explain the Good News. To grow as a parish, we must also grow as disciples in Christ. To accomplish that goal our parish must provide engaging faith formation opportunities that will help our parishioners grow spiritually.

*Goal 1: 70% of registered parishioners will participate in at least one faith formation opportunity annually by March 2026.*

*Goal 2: 75% of parishioners will report that they are growing as disciples by March 2026.*

## **Sunday Experience Priority:**

Definition/Rationale Statement: Sunday is the very heart of Christian life<sup>1</sup>, yet we all struggle to make time for the sacred in our busy lives. Good Shepherd parish is striving to be a place where we support one another in our pursuit of holiness and where we come together to be fed and sent.

As blessed Carlo Acutis said, “The Eucharist is my highway to heaven.” Our hope is to rediscover Sunday as a day when our community comes together in worship so that we might know God and ourselves more deeply... To accomplish this goal, our parish will evaluate the Sunday experience at all our parish churches to see where improvements can be made. Mass goers will be encouraged to share the Good News and be equipped to share their love and joy with those in our community and welcome them to attend Mass.

*Goal 1: 90% of people at Good Shepherd parish will report being spiritually fed through their participation in the Mass by December 2025.*

*Goal 2: Every parishioner will invite at least one person to Mass annually by December 2025.*

Definition/Rationale Statement: As a parish that exists to evangelize, we strive to strengthen our community by forming disciples who intentionally seek and welcome others. Every member of our parish will be encouraged to begin or join a small discipleship group to experience a community that supports, challenges, and encourages them in their growth as a disciple.

*Goal 1: At least 30 people become actively engaged members of a small discipleship group by March 2026.*


