# ***“Life with Christ is a wonderful adventure”***

***(Pope St. John Paul II)***

*Dear Disciple, Happy Lent!*

I invite you to enter into Holy Week with a certain practice that will open you up to experience what St Paul calls “the glorious freedom of the children of God” (Romans 8:21). It is called a media fast. This week, consider fasting from using your phone except for what’s necessary, from all TV, from all social media, YouTube, from unnecessary Internet use, etc. If you experience restlessness or an urge to check social media, sit with it, embrace it, don’t escape it. Turn to Jesus in the tabernacle of your heart and tell you love Him. Turn to Mary by your side and tell her you love her. Talk to your loving Father who gazes upon you as His dear, cherished son or daughter.

Speaking of social media, here's an example of sharing the joy and light of Christ from that sister Stephanie posted on Facebook (she is moving soon):

“We are under contract for this (house) have been praying for peace in this decision, trying to trust His perfect plan. I was given so much peace as soon as I entered NC, sign after sign that many would consider coincidence but I KNOW it was God. I felt the incredible presence of my Mom during the trip also and was moved to tears by the many signs I saw. My heart is so incredibly full with gratitude and love and I honestly can’t imagine going through life without Jesus. His joy, peace and grace are the greatest gifts I’ve ever known and I want this for everyone!! Moving and starting a new

life is stressful for sure but knowing God has us in his hands brings me so much comfort...”

St. Thérèse of the Child Jesus taught a novice : “Whenever anyone exasperates you, even to the point of making you angry, the way to regain peace of soul is to pray for that person and to ask God to reward her for giving you an opportunity to suffer.” I would add, she means suffer with love, love for God and for the person. Suffering proves our love.
