Dear Disciple, Happy Divine Mercy Sunday! "He Is Risen! He is Risen Indeed!"

St. Cyril of Jerusalem's Catechetical Lectures from the mid-fourth century are very inspiring and beautiful. They can help us to be more grateful for our own baptism, and to fan it into flame every day through silent prayer, scripture, sacraments, and service. St. Cyril reminds us that our enemy never sleeps and is always looking for a chance to attack and tempt us; we must renounce him daily.

St. Cyril describes the dramatic moment outside the door to the baptistry (place of baptism) at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem, where the elect (those "chosen" for baptism) would turn to the west, extend their hand and declare, "I renounce you, Satan, and all your works." A custom of spitting eventually arose in the Catholic Church of embellishing this renunciation of Satan with a "ptui!" — the act of spitting to the west to renounce and reject the evil one!

Then they would turn to the east, the place of light, [the place from where Jesus will return one day as the final Sunrise] and invoke the Blessed Trinity (Mystagogical Lecture, 1).

St. Cyril of Jerusalem gave the elect this homily; if you're baptized, allow him to preach to you: "Great is the Baptism that lies before you: a ransom to captives; a remission of offenses; a death of sin; a new-birth of the soul; a garment of light; a holy indissoluble seal; a chariot to heaven; the delight of Paradise; a welcome into the kingdom; the gift of adoption! But there is a serpent by the wayside watching those who pass by: beware lest he bite you with unbelief." (16)

St Augustine's words can help us to thank Jesus daily for RESCUING us from sin, death, and the devil by His death and resurrection, "Against the lion [fights] a Lion, against the wolf a Lamb. The devil was exultant when Christ died, and by that very death of Christ was the devil conquered... it's as though he took the bait in a mousetrap. He [the devil] was delighted at the death, as being the commander of death; what he delighted in, that's where the trap was set for him. The mousetrap for the devil was the cross of the Lord; the bait he would be caught by, the death of the Lord... And our Lord Jesus Christ rose again."

Following the death Pope Francis, who preached on mercy often, please pray for him ("to pray for the deceased" is a "spiritual work of mercy") in case he's undergoing purification from earthly attachments, or from the consequences of his sins that weren't fully purified on earth, in the state of Purgatory. Consider offering rosaries, prayers, eucharistic adoration, Masses/holy communions for his soul: "The Suffrage Mass is a particular type of Votive Mass in which one or more Catholic baptized believers ask the celebrating priest to offer a Mass to God in favor of the [purification] of one or more souls temporarily living in Purgatory."

This week, our regular daily Masses will be Suffrage Masses for Pope Francis: Wed. 10am, St. John; [no Thursday Mass]; Fri. 9am, St. John, followed by eucharistic adoration until 4pm and <u>Divine Mercy Chaplet</u> for the Pope at 3:45pm. Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him. May his soul and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. -Love, Fr. Nate
