





Some parishioners have expressed to me how they feel after the announcement of the closing of the St. Ignatius and St. Joseph churches. One parishioner shared that she was sick for a week when she found out. Another person (not from our parish) hugged me and said she cried with sadness when she heard. There are many strong emotions, broken hearts, and fears. One fear is that the buildings might be sold to someone who won't maintain them. Some are worried about what would happen to the items inside the churches. Some are concerned that eventually, years from now, St. John or St. Columbkille might be closed also.

Another fear is that some parishioners might eventually stop going to encounter Jesus at Mass within our parish, at a different location; or some may join another parish, or God forbid, stop going to encounter Jesus at Mass anywhere. (These fears will be mentioned at our joint parish/finance council meeting June 3, 6pm, parish center. If you desire to attend, please call the office.) How can we reach out to fellow parishioners now and during possible upcoming major changes? Will some parishioners be willing

to offer a ride to others, etc.?

I realize that this time of change and uncertain future is very, very painful for many of our brothers and sisters. 
