A Holy Moment:

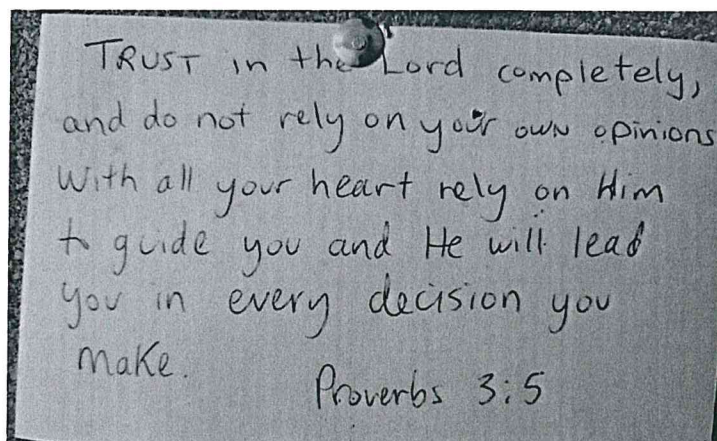
