



Christ's Mission Appeal 2025-2026

We have raised \$28,777.00 towards our goal of \$52,459.00. The new calculation for each parish's CMA is a flat 16% average of the last three year's Sunday/Holy Day collections. This calculates to the original number provided, \$46,571.00. It was later decided that the maximum change from the previous year's CMA amount would cap at 15%. Our 24-25 CMA amount was \$61,716.00, so our 25-26 could only decrease by 15% of that, coming to the updated amount of \$52,459.00.

Weekday masses will be canceled from January 19th through February 13th. Fr. Kumar made it safely to India. Thank you for your prayers.

Then there will be opportunities from now until Lent 2026 to invite that loved one back to mass. Forty percent of people invited back to mass have returned. They were just waiting to be asked.




