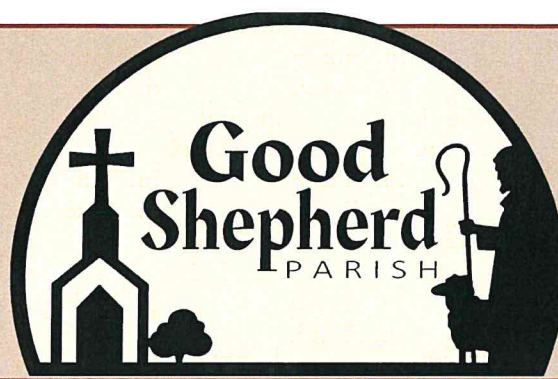

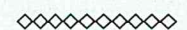

“Do Not Be Afraid”

Dear brothers and sisters,

This Sunday readings speak to a reality that every believer experiences at some point: fear. We fear rejection, criticism, failure, suffering, uncertainty, and sometimes even the consequences of living our faith openly. Into these fears, Jesus speaks a powerful message: **“Do not be afraid.”**

In the first reading, the prophet Jeremiah feels abandoned and surrounded by enemies. People are waiting for him to fail. He experiences loneliness and persecution because he has remained faithful to God’s message. Yet Jeremiah does not give up. He places his trust in the Lord and proclaims that God is with him like a mighty champion.

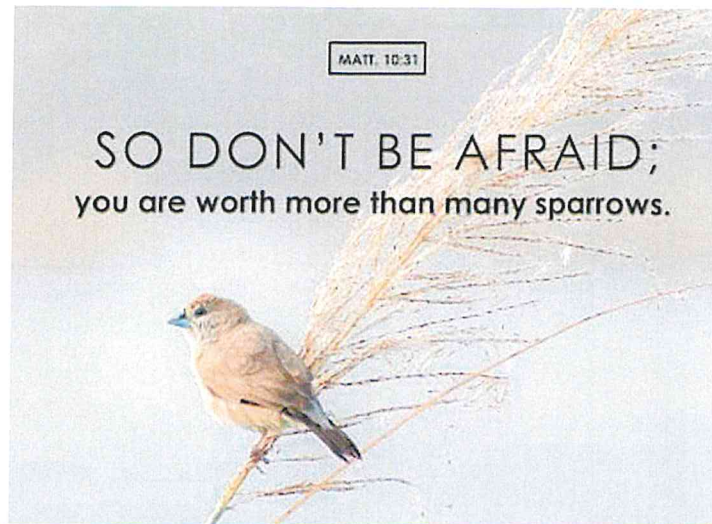
Many of us can relate to Jeremiah. There are times when doing what is right is not easy. Standing for truth, honesty, forgiveness, and Christian values can bring criticism or misunderstanding. Yet Jeremiah reminds us that God never abandons those who trust in Him.

In the Gospel, Jesus prepares His disciples for opposition. He knows they will face difficulties because of their mission. But three times He tells them, **“Do not be afraid.”** Why? Because they are precious in God’s eyes. Jesus says that even the hairs of our head are counted. This beautiful image reminds us that God knows us intimately and cares for every detail of our lives.

Fear often grows when we focus only on our problems. Faith grows when we focus on God’s presence. The disciples were not told that life would be easy; they were told that God would be with them. Christian courage is not the absence of fear but the decision to trust God despite our fears.

The second reading reminds us of another reason for hope. Through Adam, sin entered the world, but through Christ, grace has overflowed to all. Sin, fear, and death do not have the final word. God’s grace is greater than human weakness. Through Jesus Christ, we have received the gift of salvation and new life. As parishioners and families, we are called to witness to Christ in our daily lives. Parents witness to Christ when they teach their children to pray. Young people witness to Christ when they choose honesty and purity. Workers witness to Christ when they act with integrity. Every act of faith, kindness, and forgiveness becomes a testimony to God’s love.

SEMINARIAN UPDATE: Through the hard work of Fr. Andy LaFramboise and the prayers of the people of the Diocese of Saginaw, five men of the Diocese of Saginaw have applied and have been accepted by Bishop Gruss to begin studies and formation for the priesthood. Three of the men have already been accepted into a Seminary for the Fall 2026 with two men having their applications before a Seminary Admission Board for approval within the next few weeks to begin studies this Fall. Once these men have been approved, their names will be published in the Chancery Notes. These five men will join the current four seminarians in formation and studies: Michael Kuehne, Stephen Sebald, Carter Filhart, and Gerard LaFramboise. This will mean nine seminarians studying for the Diocese of Saginaw. Let's all keep praying and encouraging men to consider the Diocesan Priesthood. Together we will reach our goal of 20 seminarians by 2030.

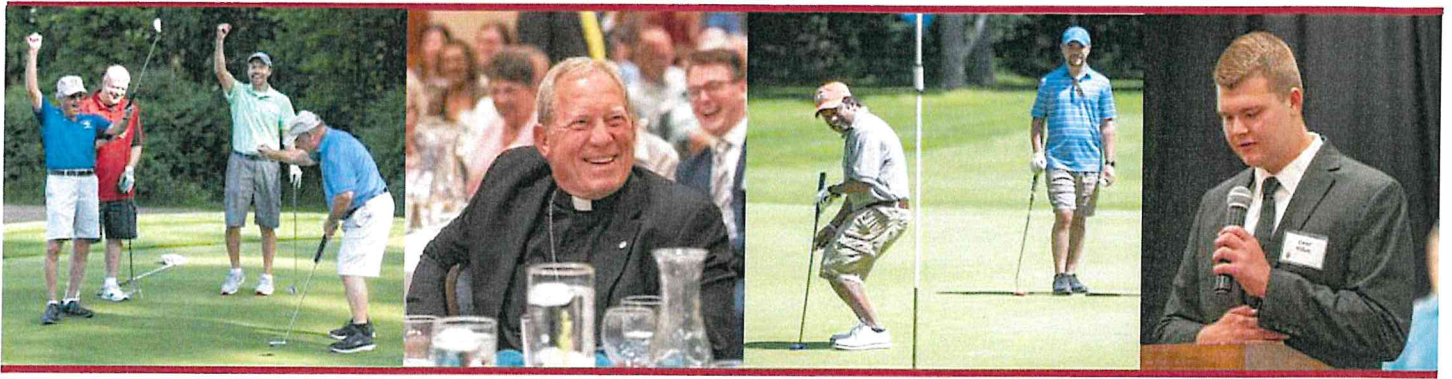
