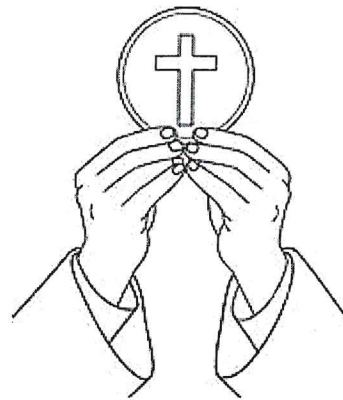
St. Ignatius teaches us that holiness is found not only in extraordinary moments but also in the ordinary events of daily life. His well-known invitation to "find God in all things" encourages us to recognize God's presence in our homes, workplaces, schools, and communities. Through prayer, reflection, and discernment, we learn to seek God's will and respond generously to His call.

One of St. Ignatius' greatest gifts to the Church is the practice of the Daily Examen, a simple prayer of reviewing the day with gratitude, recognizing God's guidance, seeking forgiveness, and renewing our desire to follow Christ more faithfully. This daily habit helps us grow in our relationship with God and become more attentive to His presence.

The Feast of St. Ignatius reminds us that our faith is meant to be lived through loving service. Like him, we are called to use our gifts for the greater glory of God, to care for those in need, to work for justice and peace, and to share the hope of the Gospel in both word and action.

As we celebrate his feast, let us ask St. Ignatius to intercede for us, that we may grow in wisdom, deepen our prayer, discern God's will in every decision, and faithfully serve Christ in all that we do. 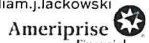

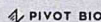
