## St. Thomas the Apostle – Apostle to India

St. Thomas the Apostle, one of the Twelve chosen by Jesus, is remembered both for his honest questioning and for his profound profession of faith in the risen Lord: *“My Lord and my God!”* (John 20:28). Strengthened by the Holy Spirit after Pentecost, he became a courageous missionary of the Gospel.

According to a long-standing Christian tradition, Thomas the Apostle traveled to India after the resurrection of Jesus Christ to preach the Gospel. The tradition holds that:

- Thomas arrived on the southwest coast of India, commonly identified as Muziris (near present-day Kerala), around **AD 52**.
- He established several early Christian communities, often referred to as the **Seven and a Half Churches** in Kerala.
- He later traveled to the east coast of India, near present-day Chennai.
- According to tradition, he was martyred around **AD 72** at St. Thomas Mount, where he is believed to have been killed with a spear while praying.
- His tomb is traditionally located at San Thome Basilica, which is built over the site long venerated as his burial place.

### Historical evidence

There is broad agreement that ancient trade routes connected the Mediterranean world with India, making travel there possible in the first century. Early Christian writers, including Origen and Eusebius of Caesarea, associated Thomas with missionary work in the East. However, the specific details of his journey to India come primarily from later traditions and texts, such as the Acts of Thomas, rather than from contemporary historical records.

As a result:

- Many Christians—especially the Syro-Malabar Church and the Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church—accept the tradition that Thomas evangelized India.
- Historians generally consider the tradition plausible because of established trade links between the Roman world and India, while recognizing that the precise details cannot be confirmed with certainty from surviving first-century evidence.

- The church in India reveres St Thomas as its founding apostle and gives thanks for the enduring legacy of faith he left behind. His life reminds that sincere questions can lead to deeper faith and every Christian is called to proclaim gospel with courage and perseverance and trust in the Risen Lord.
